Key Areas of Learning

As **historians**, we will be researching the history of England from the end of the Roman era up until the reign of Edward the Confessor. This will include considering who the Anglo Saxons were and how their lives changed with the invasion of the Vikings. We will be taking the time to explore how the Kingdom of England was eventually created.

As **scientists**, we will be following in the footsteps of Carl Linnaeus and working on classifying creatures. We will be making observations and asking questions to help us to record data and draw conclusions which will help us to group creatures together.

English

Our chosen text for our reading is 1000-Year-old boy, which we will working on together as a class.

When becoming writers, we will be looking at writing a discussion text based around our whole class reading. We will have a focus on poetry around National Poetry Day.

Maths

This term the focus is on Number.

Within Number we shall be covering Place Value and Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division.

Children will also develop their times table knowledge and recall through Times Tables Rock Stars.

RE

We will be looking at Sikhism and considering the importance of the Guru Granth Sahib.

German

This term we will be practicing how we greet people in German and giving our names and ages. We will also be learning our numbers to 12.

Computing

This term we will be developing our understanding of computer systems and how information is transferred between different systems and devices.

Art
