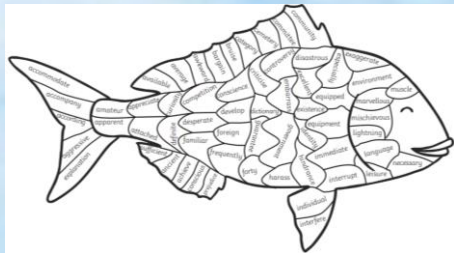


## Hometime

- If you have signed the letter to confirm your child may walk home independently, they will be released by their class teacher.
- Please ensure your child knows the arrangements for the end of the day (ie. Who is picking them up, where they are meeting or going). In the event of children not being sure, we will ask they remain with us until we receive confirmation: children's safety must remain our priority.

## Spelling

- Read Write Inc.
- 20 minutes daily whole-class learning
- Speed spell test of previous week's spelling rule every Monday
- Log book – please take home and bring back to school daily – these have the weekly spelling rule explained
- Spelling fish – statutory word lists (tested September, February and June)







## Reading

- Whole class reading sessions four times a week – books provided but feel free to bring your own copy to school
- Reading for pleasure (all the time!) – 1 dedicated session a week in school time – this is sometimes spent in the library.
- Reading provision (Reading to an adult, Lexia, comprehension skills)
- Reading at home!
